
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




1.5	Calendar	The system provides the user with a Calendar and To Do list that appears on the Learn Landing page and other RLS landing pages	This Calendar will be the same as all other calendars throughout RLS. The calendar can be populated with predetermined PD milestones and assignments by Facilitator or permitted user in a separate calendar group. Each activity in an LE/ unit page can be assigned a date. If the date is assigned to an activity, the activity becomes a milestone that populates Calendar. All dates for activities are left blank by default.
1.6	My Courses	My Courses widget displays course information and links for the courses the user is taking If Learner is not enrolled in a course, s/he will see a visual message inviting him/her to explore the catalogue.	The system shall provide a My Courses widget with individual access links to the courses that one is taking and a link to course catalog. If Learner is not enrolled, s/he will see course catalog widget (it will move up.)
1.6.1	My Courses Progress Bar	Progress Bar for the courses Displays course progress through progress bar and milestones per course. When milestones accomplished a “complete” icon appears. There is no “complete” icon when milestone is not yet accomplished.	N/A
1.6.2	Resume Button	Button links back into the course where user left off	A learner clicks “Resume” button to go back to where he/she left off last time in the course.



For example, "Professional Development", "Upper School", "Lower School", "Pedagogy", etc. When filters are applied, search result is also affected by filter.	A user select a filter to apply filter. When a filter is selected, only courses belong to this filter appear on the right side. A user could select multiple filters simultaneously. A user could combine the use of search and filter. When filters applied, search result is affected by filters. The sequence of using search and filter does not matter.

	9.1.2	Community Button	The button used to call out Community Side Panel (9.3)	When clicked, the Community Side Panel (9.3) slides in and occupies the right side of the screen, while the Current Activity (9.1) is squeezed to smaller space on the left.
	9.1.3	Progress Bar	Displays where the Learner is on this LE page and navigates between activities.	The Progress Bar is static on the page, and performs animation when Learner scrolls up or down to another activity. Also, Learner can navigate to different activities quickly by clicking the corresponding icon in Progress Bar.
	9.2	Notebook Side Panel	LE specific, where Learners take notes while learning without leaving the page.	Hidden on the left by default; can be called out by clicking Notebook Button (9.1.1). Shows all notes made in this LE. All notes (9.2.3) are collapsed by default, except the new note Learner just created (9.2.4).
	9.2.1	Course Notes Button	A button that provides Learner option to see notes taken in other LEs in this course	When clicked, the note panel shows a list of all LEs in this course that contains user notes.

	9.4	Next Activity		All activities are stacked up vertically so Learner can easily navigate between them through scrolling. However, scrolling should take Learner directly from one activity to the other, and not allow user to stop in between. See the effect on https://elementk.studio for reference. In addition, the state of Progress Bar (9.1.3) should also change accordingly when the scroll is performed.
